



Call for Applications: EU WINTER SCHOOL 2020

Environmental Protection in the EU and Environmental Challenges and Emergencies in Kosovo

3-6 February 2020

The EU Winter School is organized by *the European Young Cell Alumni Kosovo* in cooperation with *the Young Cell Scheme (Round XI-XII)* project and the *University of Prishtina 'Hasan Prishtina'*.

This year, the EUWS 2020 will focus on two main streams:

- **The Legal Aspects of Environmental Protection in the EU and the main Political Implications of the Environmental Policy of the EU**
- **The most Relevant Political and Legal Challenges of Environmental Protection in Kosovo. Cases and Solutions**

Professors from *KU Leuven, University of Tilburg, University of Aix-Marseille III, University of Prishtina (UP)*, as well as *Young Cell Alumni*, who completed their Master's studies in top EU universities and who are currently engaged in the *Civil Service* in Kosovo, will lecture on different topics related to the two main themes. In total there will be 12 lectures in 3 days and, the fourth day will be followed by a debate which will provide students with the opportunity to discuss related to the importance of environmental protection in Kosovo and to its main challenges and threats. Each student who successfully participates in the EUWS 2020 will receive an attendance certificate.



WHO CAN APPLY?

Students from all public and private Universities in Kosovo are eligible to apply.

Requirements:

- Applicants must be enrolled in the 2nd, 3rd or 4th year of their Bachelor's studies or enrolled in a Master's programme in Kosovo;
- Preferably, their field of studying should be related to environmental policy, climate change, sustainable development, international relations, law. Other applicants are encouraged to apply if they have relevant knowledge and/or

sheer interest in the above-mentioned areas;

- At least B1 or B2 level of communication in English is required (spoken and listening);
- Participation in projects, NGOs and programmes related to the above areas is considered an added value.



WHERE IS IT?

The European Winter School 2020 takes place at **the University of Prishtina 'Hasan Prishtina'**, New Amphitheater (ground floor), Faculty of Philosophy, department of Political Sciences.



WHEN IS IT?

The European Winter School 2020 will be held between **3rd and 6th of February 2020**

Courses take place from 3rd – 5th February, in two sessions: from **09:30 –13:00** and from **14:00 – 17:00**. On February 6th there will be a final debate from **10:30-12:00** and after that attendance certificates will be provided and delivered to all participants.



WHAT IS THE PRICE?

Participation fee, winter school materials, drinks and meals, are all covered by the organizers.



HOW TO APPLY?

For your application to be taken into consideration, you must:

- Fill out the application form provided for on the website of the University of Prishtina (www.uni-pr.edu);
- Submit your CV;
- Submit a motivation letter in English on why you want to attend the EUWS 2020 (200 words max.);
- Submit a proof of your student status (a scanned copy of transcripts, enrolment confirmation or any other relevant document);

- The call for application opens on 5th December 2019. The application **deadline is on 20th January 2019 at 17:00.**

Note: An **Information Day**, open to all interested students, on the contents and goals of the EUWS 2020 will be organized on **10th December 2019**, from 14:30-15:30, in the premises of the Grand Amphitheatre, National Library, Prishtina.

Shortlisted candidates will be notified by email on 24th January 2020.
